Healthy Start for Eligible Families

'Healthy Start' helps eligible pregnant people and families with children under four buy healthy food, milk and vitamins. Although Suffolk's uptake has increased to 77%, over 1,000 eligible families are still missing out.

Families can receive up to £9.30 per week, worth around £1,000 per child over four years.
