The governors and staff of St Louis feel strongly that the wearing of uniform encourages a sense of belonging and community spirit and also helps develop the right attitude to a child's work and progress.

Below is the information on our uniform:

- Uniform identified as (Mr C) must be bought from our supplier, Mr Cricket Hockey. All other items can be purchased from Mr Cricket Hockey or elsewhere.
- Winter uniform is worn from after the October half term break up to the Easter holidays with the Summer uniform being worn for the Summer term and up to the October half term break.

Children who are joining the nursery or school in September can choose to wear the winter uniform to avoid parents having to purchase two sets of uniform within a short space of time.

- Grey trousers: these should be formal in style and not made of clingy or stretchy material.
- White blouses: these should be formal in style with an open neck and rounded collar.
- Pupils should have coats in school, as outdoor play will take place in the event of light rain.
- Jewellery is not appropriate for school wear, although analogue watches may be worn. Pupils with pierced ears may wear small studs but these need to be removed for PE. If a pupil is unable to remove their earrings due to initial healing time, micropore tape (or equivalent) needs to be provided for the child to cover their earrings.
- Please ensure that all items are clearly and permanently marked with your child's name. We do not keep a "lost property box" but try to return unclaimed items as soon as possible to their owners; this is not possible if items are not named.
- Summer dresses: white shorts or short white leggings can be worn under the dress for modesty.
- Where pupils still have the old style maroon tracksuits and PE shorts they can continue to wear these.
- In Years 5 and 6, to reflect their seniority in the school, pupils are allowed to wear a maroon gold trim jumper. This is optional and children can continue to wear their plain maroon jumper or cardigan.
- Ties, Years 1-6, are not part of the summer uniform and should not be worn.
- We have a small stock of laundered spare clothing for children to wear if they do not attend in the correct uniform in error.

Hairstyles/Accessories

- Hair should be one natural colour, no hair dye.
- The style should be appropriate for school; hair should not obstruct pupils' vision.
- Tramlines, patterns and sculpting is not appropriate for school.
- Novelty headwear should not be worn.
- Pupils with long hair must have this tied back.
- Hair bands and hair ties should be a simple maroon, gold or black band to match the school uniform and be of a reasonable size.
- Children wearing incorrect bows and decorations will be asked to remove them and will be provided with a band.
